

EXECUTIVE ORDER -2021 - 4
July 16, 2021
TERMINATION OF THE DECLARATION OF
A STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE CITY OF WILMINGTON

WHEREAS, I declared a State of Emergency for the City of Wilmington on Friday, March 13, 2020 in connection with the novel Coronavirus (“COVID-19”) pandemic; and

WHEREAS, since that initial declaration I extended the State of Emergency for the City of Wilmington several times in connection with the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Delaware, John C. Carney, on July 13, 2021, terminated the State of Emergency for the State of Delaware that he had previously declared March 12, 2020, because Delaware now has the tools to prevent, control and treat COVID-19 infection, serious illness, and hospitalization, and it is therefore no longer necessary to continue the emergency orders and a full State of Emergency no longer exists;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MICHAEL S. PURZYCKI, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON DO HEREBY DIRECT AND ORDER, pursuant to the emergency provisions of Chapter 7 of the Wilmington City Code, that the March 13, 2020 State of Emergency due to COVID-19 is hereby terminated as of 12:01 a.m. Monday July 19, 2021.
