Case #1.12.21 Zoned R-3 Posted: 10/4/21 Application of Kyle Trent, 5500 Wissahickon Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19144, requesting permission to convert the building located at 1332 West 4th Street to three apartments. Applicant is also requesting to vary the side yard requirements, from 5 feet to 0 feet, for a proposed three-story rear addition.
