Cleaner and more attractive neighborhoods coming to Wilmington!

How?

The City is beginning to enforce a tough, but fair, new law known as Instant Ticketing. Those who violate the City's Sanitation Code will be cited under the new law.

How does it work?

Citizens who violate the City's sanitation code by *improperly disposing or placing trash for pick-up, or by allowing high grass, weeds, junk and debris, or fecal matter* to litter their property are now subject to an instant \$50.00 fine. Citizens who fail to clean-up the mess they created could receive additional \$50.00 instant fines!

What can I expect from the new law?

Cleaner and more attractive neighborhoods!! If we care about our community and our neighbors and abide by the sanitation code by keeping our property looking clean and maintained, we can expect a better looking City.

What can violators expect from the new law?

They will receive a \$50.00 instant ticket to remind them of their obligation and duty to follow the law! Maybe a few instant tickets of \$50.00 will be enough of an incentive to force violators to pay attention to their responsibility as citizens!
